### **Reading and Writing**

This term we continue to adopt a text-based approach to our literacy and topic lessons. This half term, our first book will be 'Wisp' by Zana Fraillon underpinning key themes: Refugee living, home, hope and freedom. Our second key text will be 'Beowulf' by Michael Morpurgo, an epic Anglo-Saxon legend about strength, courage and defeat

#### Maths

This half term, children will be expected to apply their knowledge of the four operations and we will focus on multiplication and division, recognising and solving problems with fractions and decimals, learning to tell the time and solving problems with money using the decimal notation.

Regular times table practise will continue to be a focus. It is an expectation that by May, all children know all of their times tables and have rapid recall of them in random order. Children must practise daily at home.

#### Curriculum

We will be continuing with our thematic curriculum that creates meaningful links between the children's learning in English, science, humanities and creative arts with our key text as the main driver.

Science: Children will work scientifically to explore pitch and volume and complete an investigation involving soundproofing.

Art: Children create a drawing and painting of the local environment. they will explore the use of light and dark in painting with a focus on colour mixing, tint, tone and shade.

History: Children will study who the Anglo Saxons and Vikings were as well as why they invaded and settled in Britain.

#### Homework
