Topic Overview & Key Text

On the Way Home

This is a story all about a little girl's journey as she walks home. We will learn the story off by heart and think carefully about the themes in the story.

We will use the story to help us to learn about the different animals that appear such as snakes.

Maths

We will continue thinking carefully about how numbers to 10 are made up. We will remember some addition facts which are also called number bonds. i.e. 5+5=10

We will learn double facts and continue investigating odd and even numbers.

Writing

We will also be practicing writing simple sentences that can be read by others. We will all learn how to 'hold a sentence' as we try to write all of the words that we can hear in our sentence.

We will use these skills to write fact files about different animals in the story.

The children will continue learning how to read words with 'special friends' – digraphs as well as treading short sentences and captions. Help your child at home by reading with them every evening for at least ten minutes.
