Welcome back to Year 3! We are excited to see everyone and introduce our new Summer 2 topics. Here is some information on what we will be learning about this half term.

#### **Topic Overview & Key Text**

This term we will continue to use a text-based approach to our literacy and topic lessons. In Summer 2, 'Egyptology' by Dugald Steer will lead our learning.

Egyptology is Emily Sands' lavish 1926 scrapbook journal of a lost expedition.



#### Maths

This term we will consolidate our knowledge of place value, addition and subtraction and multiplication and division in our lessons. We will then focus on revisiting how to tell the time on analogue and digital clocks as well as a variety of time related maths problems.

Regular time tables practice will also be a focus.

#### Writing

In writing the children will be focussing on writing their own adventure stories. Together we will learn how to write character descriptions, setting descriptions and dialogues based on 'The Adventures of Tintin: Cigars of the Pharaoh' by Herge.

#### Reading

Within the reading unit, we will be continuing to embed skills such as: drawing inferences, making predictions and asking questions to improve our understanding of the text. We will also continue to complete weekly reading comprehension assessments in class. Our texts will be focussing on Ancient Egypt and adventure stories.

#### **Home Reading**

It is so important for your child to be a regular reader at home. Children will also continue to earn tokens for every ten minutes of reading that is signed by an adult. If your child is a fluent reader, then you do not need to listen to them read. However, you could question your child's understanding of the text. Please see our Parental Comment guide overleaf. Children will also continue to earn tokens for every ten minutes of reading that is signed by an adult.

#### Homework

We will be using SeeSaw to set homework. Homework will be issued on Monday to be completed before the following Monday. Children are also expected to read every day at home.
