

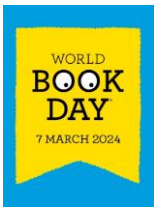


St John's Newsletter

British Science Week

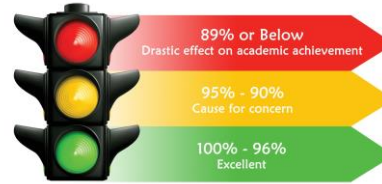
We love science at St John's! Our teachers are busy planning some exciting activities ready for British Science
